## Michigan Chapter of the Antique & Classic Boat Society

On June 26<sup>th</sup> the Michigan Chapter of the Antique and Classic Boat Society (ACBS) presented the 25th annual Chris Craft Plant Jamboree hosted by the Algonac Harbour Club, site of the original Chris Craft Plant. The Algonac show is the premier local antique boat show and has been in existence for a total of 31 years. Approximately 85 boats were registered for the show in 15 different classes. Boats ranged in length from a 7' hydroplane up to 57' Chris Craft, and in age from 1925 Chris Craft up to a 2009 "Contemporary Classic." The DYC was well represented with three members winning six awards with five different boats. The following DYC members won awards:
