DYC USA SWIM TEAM 2010-2011

The DYC Winter Swim Team is a USA Swimming team. USA Swimming is a national organization that governs amateur competitive swimming with numerous meets at different skill levels.

The team runs from August 30 through mid-May divided into three sessions: Fall, Winter and Spring. The team is open to all DYC members' children. Our first practice will be August 30th at 5:30. Please feel free to come up to the pool deck and meet with our coaches.

We focus on providing individual attention for all competitive swimmers from novice to the highly experienced. The program welcomes children who want to become stronger, confident swimmers as well as those who want to excel at the state level and national level. Training emphasizes both stroke work and conditioning. A unique feature of our program is the ratio of coaches to swimmers. Most practices will have fewer than 7 swimmers per coach.

We have multiple levels in our program to accommodate swimmers at all levels of ability. Coaches place swimmers in groups that will maximize training benefits at their own level of skill and interest.

The fall session will begin on August 30. Signup information will be available on August 30 or on the pool deck.
