Saturday, October 9th -

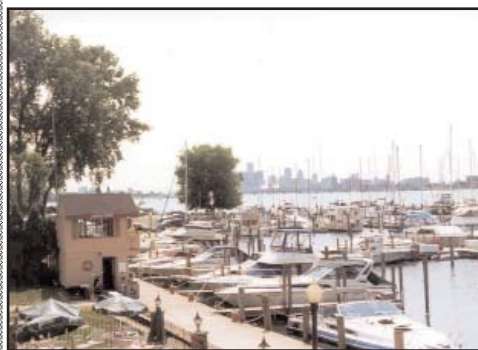
