SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

MODIFICATIONS TO 2018 DRYA SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Detroit Regional Yacht-Racing Association's "Notice of Race" and "2018 DRYA Standard Sailing Instructions for "A" and "C" Courses" ("2018 DRYA Sailing Instructions") are adopted with the following modifications:

NEW PARAGRAPH A – JIB AND MAIN RACE - ENTRIES is added:

Jib & Main Race

The Jib & Main Race, Start No. C-1 on C Course, is open to keelboats from all DRYA and ILYA clubs with PHRF JAM ratings of 64 or higher. Boats racing in this class must have a PHRF rating issued by DRYA and either be on the DRYA Valid List or the DRYA PJAM List or must submit an application for a DRYA Certificate for PJAM rating by midnight Tuesday Sept. 4th 2018. Application and Payment are on the drya.org home page.

IN ADDITION, ANY GUEST BOAT RACING IN THE JAM RACE MUST REGISTER ON_LINE AT drya.org TO ACCOMMODATE DRYA SCORING IN THE JAM CLASS. Unregistered boats will have their Sail numbers, boat type and start and finish times recorded and given to DYC for determination of awards.

Boats racing in the JAM class must fly their club's burgee on the backstay approximately 6 feet above the deck. (This modifies 2018 DRYA Sailing Instructions, paragraph 6.) Boats in the Jib & Main Class will participate only in race one on C Course. Boats in the Jib & Main Race will sail the Long Course as described in Instruction "C3" of 2018 DRYA Sailing Instructions.

PARAGRAPH 5 - CLASS FLAGS is modified to read as follows:

The JAM class shall have only one race. All other classes may have one or more races which shall constitute this Regatta. All races started and not abandoned shall be scored for the Regatta, as described in the 2018 DRYA Sailing Instructions. Races following the first race may be started in any order, as determined by the respective course's Race Committee, and will utilize the class/starting flags noted in these Sailing Instructions.

RADIO MONITORING: As a reminder, the Race Committee will monitor: Channel 72 for the "A" Course Channel 71 for the "C" Course.

REGATTA AWARDS PARTY: Detroit Yacht Club Sweepstakes Regatta awards party will be held at the DYC following the race on Saturday, Sept. 8. Visiting boats may contact the Harbormaster at 313-824-1200 or harbormaster@dyc.com for advance dockage arrangements or may hail on VHF Channel 9 or 68 when entering the vicinity of the harbor. Parking is available at DYC for those arriving by car; please identify yourself as a Regatta participant at the DYC gate and DYC visitor at Belle Isle State Park permit booth. Food & drinks will be available for purchase at DYC. Regatta party is scheduled to begin at 3:00pm with awards to be made at approximately 4:00pm.
