SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

MODIFICATIONS TO 2019 DRYA SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Detroit Yacht Club (the Sponsoring Club), adopts the Detroit Regional Yacht-Racing Association's *"Notice of Race"* and *"2019 DRYA Standard Sailing Instructions for "A" and "C" Courses"* (*"2019 DRYA Sailing Instructions"*) for this Regatta, with the following modifications:

NEW PARAGRAPH A – JIB AND MAIN RACE - ENTRIES is added:

Jib & Main Race

The Jib & Main (JAM) Race, Start No. C-1 on C Course, is open to keelboats from all DRYA and ILYA clubs with PHRF JAM ratings of 59 or higher. Boats racing in the JAM class must fly their club's burgee on the backstay approximately 6 feet above the deck. (This modifies 2019 DRYA Sailing Instructions, paragraph 6.)

JAM Race Ratings and Registration

To be scored in this Regatta in the JAM race, boats must pre-register with DRYA (www.drya.org) in accordance with DRYA NOR Paragraph 3. **JAM REGISTRATIONS MUST BE RECEIVED BY DRYA BEFORE 0930AM ON THURSDAY, SEPT. 5, 2019.**

In addition, boats participating in this race must have a PHRF rating issued by DRYA and either be on the DRYA Valid List or have a Provisional Jib and Main (PJAM) Rating issued by DRYA. A PJAM application must be submitted to DRYA by Tuesday, Sept. 3, 2019.

The Jib & Main Class will sail only one race.

PARAGRAPH 5 - CLASS FLAGS is modified to read as follows:

The JAM class shall have only one race. All other classes may have one or more races which shall constitute this Regatta. All races started and not abandoned shall be scored for the Regatta, as described in the 2019 DRYA Standard Sailing Instructions. Races following the first race may be started in any order, as determined by the respective course's Race Committee, and will utilize the class/starting flags noted in these Sailing Instructions.

PARAGRAPH 6.1 – RACE REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS is adopted and supplemented with the following information: **The deadline for registration is Tuesday midnight Sept. 3, 2019 for boats requiring new ratings and Thursday 9:30AM 9/5/2019 for boats already having a rating and shall apply to all of the following situations: (1) a boat registered for the 2019 DRYA Counter Series but not intending to race in her designated class (for example, JAM race participants, see Sailing Instruction Paragraph A above), (2) a boat sailing in the JAM race with a PJAM rating, or (3) a boat not registered with DRYA and sailing as an invited guest of the Detroit Yacht Club. Registration is available via the DRYA website www.drya.org before the registration deadline.**

RADIO MONITORING: As a reminder, the Race Committee will monitor:

Channel 72 for the "A" Course

Channel 71 for the "C" Course

REGATTA AWARDS: Detroit Yacht Club Sweepstakes Regatta awards will be presented at the DYC approximately 3 hours following the finish of the final race on the A Course.

Regatta participants are welcome to enjoy lunch or dinner in the DYC restaurant or Grill Bar and evening band entertainment at the Red Bar in Starlight Circle. Parking is available at DYC for those arriving by car; please identify yourself as a Regatta participant at the DYC gate and DYC visitor at Belle Isle State Park permit booth.
