ENTRIES

The following participants may enter the Regatta: (1) DRYA 2023 "Counter Series Boats" as of Tues., Sept. 5, 2023, (2) DYC member-owned boats as DYC Club Race entries (as an Invited Boat of the Detroit Yacht Club, the Sponsoring Club), and (3) Invited Boats racing in a class other than the DYC Club Race and who have complied with the requirements of DRYA NOR Section 3. Invitations may be requested by emailing the Sponsoring Club at <u>dycsailingcommittee@gmail.com</u>. Please include boat owner name & contact info, boat name/sail number, boat design including year & length. Invitation requests must be submitted no later than Sun., Sep. 3, 2023.

DYC Club Race* is open to Detroit Yacht Club members only and will be scored separately from all other classes sailing in this Regatta. DYC Club Race class participants may use spinnaker or other headsail and will be scored using a rating reflecting the headsail configuration used for the Regatta. Ratings will default to the participant's Off-the-Dock JAM rating unless the boat opts to sail with spinnaker (by notifying <u>dycsailingcommittee@gmail.com</u>) or actually does so in the race.

REGISTRATION

Registration in accordance with DRYA NOR Section 3 is required for a boat to be scored in this Regatta. Registration of Invited boats on the DRYA website, including payment of any fees required by DRYA, must be completed on or before Tues., Sep. 5. DRYA Counter Series boats will be automatically entered in this regatta in their respective class and need not separately register. Invited Boat invitations will be compiled and submitted to DRYA by the Sponsoring Club.

Registration is required for the following: (1) DRYA Counter Series boats intending to sail in any class (including DYC Club Race) not their designated class, and (2) Invited Boats not registered with DRYA as a Counter Series Boat. However, Detroit Yacht Club member boats registered for the DYC 2023 Off-the-Dock Racing Series as of Sep. 5, 2023, will automatically be entered by the DYC Sailing Committee for the DYC Club Race unless the boat is registered for the DRYA Counter Series. As permitted per DRYA 2023 NOR, there is no fee for a DYC member boat to participate in this Club Race.

MODIFICATIONS TO 2023 DRYA SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The Detroit Yacht Club (the Sponsoring Club) adopts the Detroit Regional Yacht-Racing Association *Notice of Race* and the 2023 *DRYA Sailing Instructions for AC Course (DRYA SI)* for this Regatta with the modifications herein. This will be a DRYA W/L Regatta on the AC Course. The Detroit Yacht Club is the Organizing Authority (OA) for this regatta. Where conflicts occur between this SSI and the DRYA documents this SSI shall prevail.

PARAGRAPH 7 - STARTING SEQUENCE & CLASS FLAGS is modified to read as follows: ORDER OF STARTS First Warning Signal is at 1030 hours

CLASSES SHALL BE STARTED TOGETHER ACCORDING TO START NUMBERS LISTED BELOW:

For the DYC Club Race* there shall be only one race. DYC Club Race and DRYA Club JAM class will start together under DYC Burgee and will be scored separately. Boats sailing in the DRYA Club JAM must be registered with DRYA and are NOT required to display a club burgee to be scored. This changes DRYA SI 7.2. DRYA Counter Series boats sailing shorthanded pursuant to DRYA SI 7.3 are NOT required to display a club burgee but must follow requirements of SI 7.3 to be scored. DYC Club Race boats MUST display a DYC burgee on their backstay as required under DRYA SI 7.2 to be scored in the DYC Club Race.

REGATTA AWARDS: Detroit Yacht Club Sweepstakes Regatta awards will be presented at DYC on Saturday, Sept. 9, beginning approximately 90 minutes following the final finishes of the race. Visiting boats should contact the Harbormaster in advance at 313-824-1200 or <u>harbormaster@dyc.com</u> for availability of dockage arrangements. Parking is available at DYC for those arriving by car; please identify yourself as a Regatta participant at the DYC gate and DYC visitor at Belle Isle State Park permit booth.
